City of Jonestown Private Property Debris Removal Program (PPDR)

The City of Jonestown is accepting applications for PPDR through FEMA that can assist residents with the removal of potentially eligible flood-generated debris from private property.





How to apply:

Complete an online application by scanning the QR code

This program is offered at no cost for eligible participants



Types of eligible flood-generated debris include:

- Vegetative debris
- Construction and demolition debris
- White goods (household appliances)
- Household hazardous waste

Required Documents:

- Most Recent Tax Bill/Record ***(NOT OPTIONAL)
- A copy of the insurance policy and proof of statement of loss (if the property was insured)
- Valid Driver's License or State Issued I.D.
- Proof of property ownership (e.g., warranty deed, tax assessment, mortgage statement)
- Trust documents (if the property is held in a trust)
- Articles of Incorporation (if the property is owned by a corporation)
- Power of Attorney (if an authorized agent is acting on behalf of the property owner)

Eligible Debris:

Eligible debris must be the direct result of the recent floods and must be located within the City of Jonestown. To be considered eligible, the removal of the debris must be in the public interest, meaning its removal:

- Eliminates immediate threats to life, public health, or safety
- Eliminates immediate threats of significant damage to improved public or private property
